HOW TO REGISTER ?

-  Already have a partner? Great! Simply register on Pickleball Global, create your account, and make sure your DUPR ID is linked. During registration, choose your category, and then select your partner from the drop-down menu.
-  Don't have a partner yet? No problem! You can still register on Pickleball Global, and we'll help you find a partner. Just register as usual, and we'll work on matching you with someone.
-  DUPR Account: Regardless of whether you have a partner or not, you must create an account on DUPR and link your DUPR ID to your Pickleball Global profile. This is required for registration.
-  Registration Confirmation: Once you've completed your registration, you'll receive an email confirming the events you've signed up for.
-  Partnering Up: If someone else adds you as their partner, you'll need to confirm by responding to their email within 18 hours. If you don't confirm, their status will change to "Looking for a Partner."



RULES & REGULATIONS

-  The tournament will follow the official USA Pickleball Rulebook as a guideline. However, the Tournament Committee reserves the right to make the final decision on any dispute or other matters that may arise.
-  All start times are subjected to change and might not follow what has been posted. Players will have to check Pickleball Global website for the latest updates.
-  Changes to doubles teams/partners are allowed if a team is a no-show, but only if confirmed before their first match. The Tournament Committee has the right to make any changes as long as the matches have not started. Once a team is defaulted after 10 minutes, no replacements are allowed.
-  If a player misses the first match but is available later, they can still participate.
-  Players still have a chance to qualify in the round-robin format even with a loss in the first match.
-  All match results will be submitted and updated on DUPR & Pickleball Global.
-  Teams that arrive more than 10 minutes late or fail to appear for their scheduled match will automatically forfeit, with a default score of either 0-15 or 0-21 recorded.
-  The Tournament Committee may close registration early if all available slots are filled – even if this occurs before the stated registration deadline.
-  The tournament committee reserves the right to merge the categories if there are not enough participants to run a particular category.
-  The tournament committee reserves the right to modify, postpone, or cancel the tournament due to unforeseen circumstances. In such cases, registration fees will be refunded to participants, after deduction of administrative charges of RM10.00.



TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. Registration

- All participants must complete their registration, including full payment and confirmation of a playing partner, before the registration deadline. Late entries or incomplete registrations will not be accepted.
- Registration fees are non-refundable unless the event is cancelled by the organizer. In such cases, refunds will be issued after deducting an administrative fee of RM10.
- If a category receives less than its target number of entries, the prize amount may be adjusted accordingly.
- The organizer reserves the right to reassign players to a more appropriate category if their skill level exceeds the registered division.
- The organizer reserves the right to merge the categories if there are not enough participants to run the category.
- Participants are responsible for their own travel and accommodation arrangements. The organizer will not be held liable for related costs.

2. Check-In

- All players must check in at the registration desk at least 30 minutes prior to their scheduled mat.
- A valid identification document (NRIC or passport) must be presented upon check-in. Participants are also required to sign a waiver form.

3. Code of Conduct

- Players are expected to maintain good sportsmanship and follow all tournament rules. Any form of misconduct or unsportsmanlike behavior may result in disqualification.

4. Health & Safety

- While the organizers will strive to ensure a safe and well-managed environment, participants are responsible for their own health and fitness to compete.
- By joining the tournament, players accept the inherent risks of playing pickleball and agree not to hold WPC Malaysia or the organizing committee liable for any injuries sustained.

5. Dress Code

- Appropriate athletic attire and non-marking court shoes are required for all participants.

6. Personal Belongings

- Participants are advised to bring minimal valuables to the venue.
- Each player is responsible for securing their own belongings. The organizer will not be held responsible for any loss or damage.

7. Dispute Resolution

- Any disputes must be brought to the attention of the referee or tournament director during the match in question.
- Only disputes involving scoring errors or rule violations will be reviewed. No retrospective appeals will be entertained once the match has concluded.
